

St. Joseph Day Of Work & Evangelization

August 21 marked the St. Joseph day of work and evangelization at St. Benedict Rectory. The Knights of Columbus and members of the Youth Ministry Core team sponsored the project which included sealing the perimeter wood fence and taking down the aged green house in the rectory patio.

The day started with mass as Fr. Enzo delivered one of his stellar homilies, followed by a hearty breakfast prepared by chef, Fr. Frank Kelly. There was an evangelization moment that focused on the life of St. Joseph, followed by a work period, and then hamburgers and hotdogs were served for lunch.
